Tequila Sunrise: tequila, orange juice & grenadine

This comes from the West coast & is named because its gradation of color look like a sunrise.

Harvey Wallbanger: vodka, orange juice & Galliano [Italian sweet herbal liqueur]

Rumored to be created by a free-spirited California surfer in the 1970's.

Rum & Coke: white rum & Coca-Cola

WWII Vets discovered this drink in Trinidad and brought it back to the States.

Scotch & Soda: blended Scotch whisky with club soda

Seven & Seven: Seagram Seven Crown Whiskey & 7-Up
